<p>Part I:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- box I.11: Name and address of the establishment which merges the final consignment</li> <li>- box I.15: the registration number should be given.</li> <li>- box I.17: import permit is required for import of uncooked prawns to Australia</li> </ul> <p>(1) Example: farmed origin, wild origin.  (2) For cooked prawns/shrimps declare fully cooked or cooked to the core.  (3) Abnormal prawns with visible lesions or physical damage  (4) Delete as appropriate  (5) Uncooked peeled, highly processed prawns = prawns that have had their head, legs and shell removed (last shell segment and tail fans permitted) AND been further processed.  (6) Graded means that Inspectors would conduct an organoleptic (touch, smell, visual) assessment, that allows abnormal (infected or contaminated, with loose, limp cephalothorax, discoloration or visible lesions) prawns to be identified and rejected, or diverted for further processing.  (7) The signature and the stamp must be different to that of the printing.</p>
