Norway is recognized by OIE as having risk status as negligible BSE risk. Norway satisfies the condition in chapter 11.5 of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code.

Norway has a surveillance program according to Regulation (EC) no. 999/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2001 laying down rules for the prevention, control and eradication of certain transmissible spongiform encephalopathies.

Milk and dairy products produced in Norway derived from cows which were officially free from BSE at the time of milking, and that the milk products in that respect are fit for human consumption.
