IV. I, being an official veterinarian of the Government of Norway, declare the following:

- 1) The following diseases have never been reported in Norway: Aujeszky's Disease, Vesicular Stomatitis, Rinderpest, Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy, African Swine fever.
- 2) Norway has been free from Foot and Mouth Disease since 1952 and Swine Fever (Hog Cholera) since 1963.
- 3) The semen is derived from boars clinically free from: Anthrax, Brucellosis, Transmissible Gastroenteritis, Swine Influenza, Trichomoniasis, Porcine Respiratory Coronavirus (PRCV), Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome (PRRS), Porcine Epidemic Diarrhoea (PED), Teschen Disease, Rabies, Melioidosis, Vesicular Stomatitis, Campylobacteriosis, West Nile Virus.
- 4) The donor boars come from an artificial insemination centre where all animals have been tested and found free from Aujeszky's Disease, Brucellosis (suis), Leptospirosis and Tuberculosis
- 5) In Norway both Trichomoniasis and Campylobacteriosis are unknown as clinical swine diseases.
- 6) The semen is derived from an artificial insemination centre which is licensed by the Norwegian Animal Health Authority, and is under supervision of a veterinary surgeon.
