- b) Has been prepared and stored in a dedicated fish processing plant approved, validated and supervised by the competent authority, in ways that prevent cross-contamination of category 3 material with category 1 and 2 materials;
- c) Has been derived from fish and other sea animals, except sea mammals, caught in the open sea for the purposes of fish meal production and/or fresh fish materials from establishments manufacturing products for human consumption;
- d) The product does not contain and is not derived from bovine, ovine or caprine materials other than those derived from animals born, continuously reared and slaughtered in a country or region classified as posing a negligible BSE risk by a decision in accordance with Article 5(2) of Regulation (EC) No 999/2001;
- e) Has met requirements in accordance with Regulation (EC) 142/2011 Annex X, Chapter II, Section 3;
- f) The final product was packaged in new packing material or in the case of dispatch as bulk transport: container or any other means of transport was thoroughly cleaned and disinfected with a disinfectant approved by the competent authority before use;
- g) The packaging bear labels indicating "NOT FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION".
